

# New Brunswick Travel Registration Program



Effective September 22, every person entering New Brunswick must pre-register. This includes New Brunswickers re-entering the province.\*

\* The requirement to register travel does not apply to a commercial truck driver entering or re-entering New Brunswick for the purpose of delivering goods.

## Before entering New Brunswick, know the requirements for:

### FULLY VACCINATED

- Pre-register travel
- Proof of vaccination
- No isolation required
- No testing

\* Individuals who cannot receive a vaccine because of a medical exemption will be required to provide proof of exemption signed by a health care provider.

### UNVACCINATED (or partially vaccinated)

- Pre-register travel
- Isolate for 14 days
- Testing on or after day 10
  - Released from isolation following negative test result

\* All children who are younger than the approved vaccination age are exempt from isolation unless travelling with family members who are required to isolate.
